Stiff under sail, with a tulip bow that keeps the deck dry despite the waves. Worth seeing, for lovers of beautiful boats.

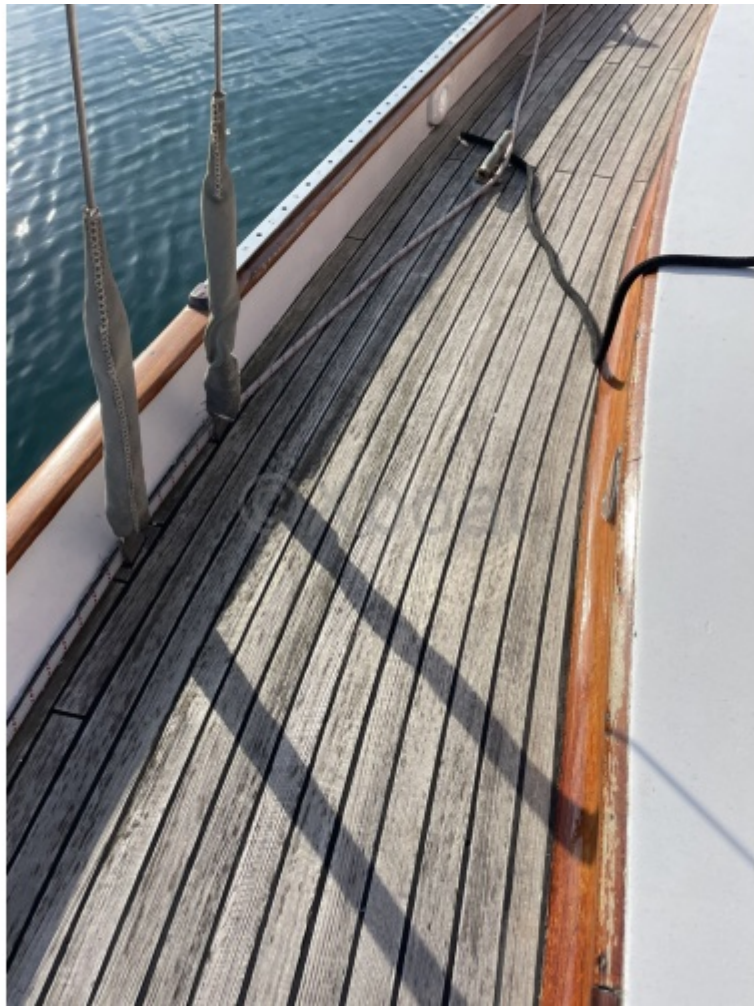
























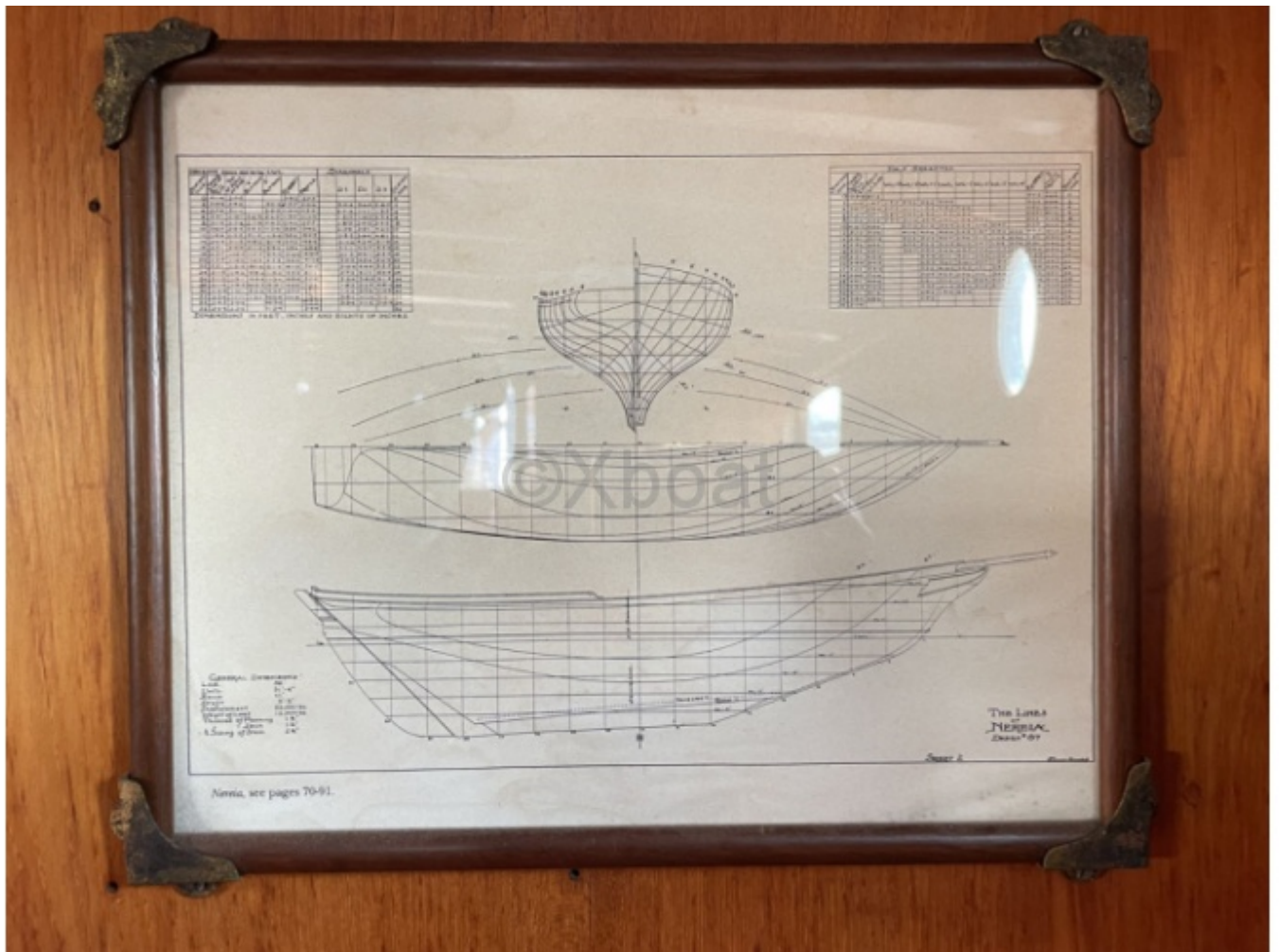
