Owner's Comments

The owner writes: OCEANIS 351 with 3 cabins and short keel with fins, fully refitted between 2020 and 2022, new engine in 2021, standing rigging in 2021, double set of sails, delphinium and cockpit enclosure in 2022, sold due to health reasons. Hull sandblasted in 2018. > Recent electronics with Raymarine ST60 navigation system and cockpit repeaters, Garmin Echomap 922 GPS/plotter, Navionics Europe and wide EL22 charts, Garmin AIS 800 transceiver, Navicom RT 750 VHF, portable VHF, radar, and autopilot on the steering pedestal. > Electricity/Energy updated with 220V power outlets, 12V phone charging ports, interior/exterior LED lighting, EFOY 80 fuel cell, 2 x 220 Ah service batteries, VICTRON 30 Ah battery charger, and 50-meter MARINCO dockside power cable. > Onboard living improved with 2 x TVs, Techimpex 2-burner gas stove 2021, microwave oven 2023, JABSCO electric head, all valves replaced in 2020/21, 2 x 200 L freshwater tanks, water system refitted in 2021 (pump and accumulator), new 20 L Sigmar hot water tank 2021, bilge pump and filter new 2024, electric Jabsco head, automatic shower sump pump and filters 2024, mixer faucet 2021, deck panels and hatches partially replaced. > The boat is equipped with a Seago 4-person life raft from 2020, a mechanical windlass with clutch for its 50-meter main anchor chain (8mm, 2022), a delphinium in stainless steel and teak for storing the Delta anchor and the gennaker tack, and a friction boom brake. > Pleasant to live on under the sun with its easy access to the aft platform, the joys of swimming, and its performance, the Oceanis 351 is also convivial at anchor with its open saloon and its classic, tasteful interior decor. > The Oceanis 351 sailboat, designed by Berret-Racoupeau and built by the Bénéteau shipyard, has a hull length of 10.40 meters for a maximum beam of 3.80 meters. It was launched in 1992. More details and viewing upon request.
