The owner states: THE BOAT WILL BE AVAILABLE EARLY SEPTEMBER 2025 Dufour 325 Grand Large, built in 2008, model year 2009, general description: - Hand-laminated polyester/fiberglass hull. - NPG gelcoat with first layer of NPG resin-impregnated fabric forming an optimal barrier against osmosis. - Molded keel, laminated floors to the hull. Hull ports in the saloon. - PVC sandwich deck, injection-molded for significant weight savings and excellent finish. - Draft 1.85m, lead keel, keel bolts reinforced with stainless steel plates. - NEW Volvo D120 engine, 115 hours of use. - Semi-elliptical rudder blade, filled with closed-cell foam. Solid stainless steel rudder stock. - Teak handrails on the cabin top. Spinnaker pole track. - Self-draining anchor locker with mooring cleat and integrated windlass support, hatch with lock. - Stem fitting with single roller davit. Fore deck with wooden seating and green/red navigation lights. - Aft decks with life ring support, flagstaff support, navigation lights, and opening pulpit with hook. - Stanchions with 2 levels of lifelines. - 4 aluminum mooring cleats. - Single stainless steel chainplate for shrouds and lower shrouds. 2 chainplates for spreaders. 1 water and 1 fuel tank. - Main sail outhaul on the cabin top. Halyard with 4:1 purchase and cascade. - Genoa tracks with cars. 2 single blocks for genoa sheet leads on the lifelines. - 1 4:1 organizer on deck for halyard leads. - Stainless steel gooseneck for electrical and electronics. 4 blocks on the cabin top. - 2 halyard winches on the cabin top. - 2 self-tailing genoa sheet winches on the lifelines. - Cockpit seats and helm seat covered in teak. Cockpit sole in polyester with non-slip surface. Wheel steering. - 1 large side locker with closing hatch. - Rudder stock under the helm seat for emergency tiller installation. Engine controls and panel on the starboard side of the cockpit, within reach. - Center-opening transom by removing the helm seat, allowing access to the stern. Gas bottle storage in the starboard aft locker. - Liferaft storage in the cockpit locker, cockpit shower in the starboard aft locker. Bathing ladder. - Aluminum mast anodized with 2 stages of spreaders, rigged 9/10, deck-stepped. Deck lights, deck steering lights. - Boom vang tacks. - Anodized aluminum boom equipped with 2 continuous reefing lines. Furler. - Grounded rigging. Continuous standing rigging in single-strand stainless steel and chromed bronze turnbuckles including: forestay, double spreaders, shrouds, inters. - Running rigging in pre-stretched textile including: main and genoa halyards, boom vang, main and genoa sheets, 2 continuous reefing lines, reefing line adjustment, furler line, purchase for. - Main sail with 2 wide reefing lines, battens, and sail cover. - Furling genoa with UV protection. - Asymmetric spinnaker. The ventilation is provided by 2 deck hatches with integrated vents, 4 opening ports on the cabin top with curtains, 2 "mushroom" vents. - 2 hull ports and 2 fixed ports on the cabin top. THE BOAT WILL BE AVAILABLE EARLY SEPTEMBRE 2025
