Description of the Nauticat 52

The **Nauticat 52** is a **monohull cruising sailboat** designed by naval architect **Sparkman & Stephens** and built by the Finnish shipyard **Siltala Yachts** starting in 1981. It is particularly appreciated for its **robustness**, **seagoing comfort**, and its ability to sail safely over long distances.

Maintenance and Equipment

I purchased this **Nauticat 52** in the fall of 2024 in a dry port and put it back in the water in mid-April 2025 after a **general maintenance**. Here are the works carried out:

- Hull cleaned and polished
- Complete antifouling with new anodes
- Engine drained and new filters
- New stuffing box

- Propeller shaft checked
- Electrical network brought up to standard and new main mast wiring
- Lithium batteries
- 2 x 300W solar panels
- New wind vane
- New fenders
- Running rigging partially new

The boat is equipped with a **100 M mooring line** on a **40 Kg anchor**. It also has the following electronic equipment:

- Fixed VHF ASN RADIO OCEAN RO 6800 AIS
- Fixed VHF ICOM IC M 401
- AIS CTRX Class B
- EPIRB Beacon MC MURDO MC3
- 2 x toilets including 1 electric and 1 manual

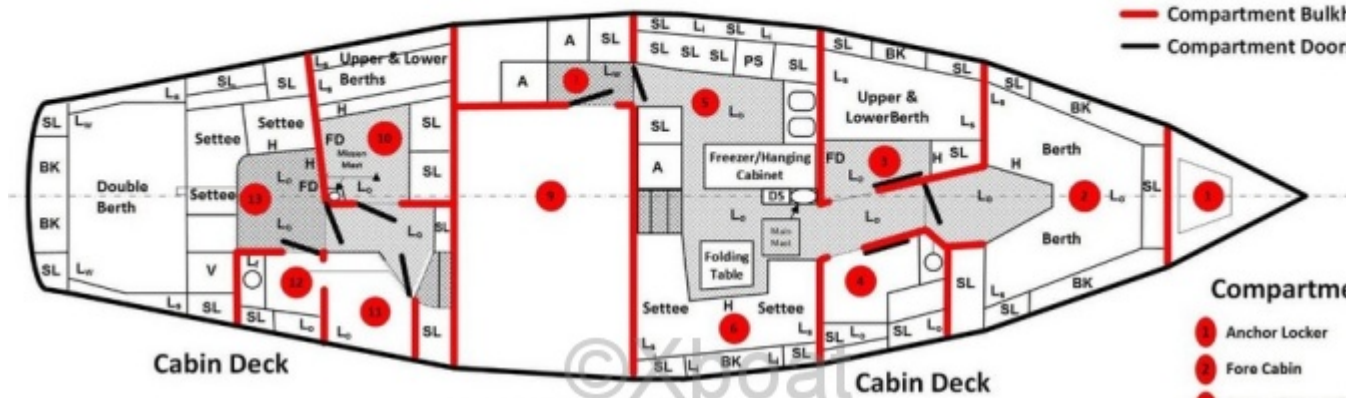
