Whether you work remotely or simply enjoy life at anchor, **energy independence** is guaranteed.

Engine and Maintenance

The **engine** is in excellent condition - only **1800 hours**, with rigorous maintenance carried out according to the manufacturer's schedule. This year, we inspected the **standing rigging** and replaced the essential elements to ensure safety and reliability on ocean crossings. The **sails** and **running rigging**, on the other hand, are reaching the end of their life and will need to be replaced before undertaking new major navigations - a point already taken into account in the asking price.

History of the Shipyard and the Model

The **Beneteau Oceanis 43** was designed by **Berret-Racoupeau** and its interior by **Nauta Design**. It was first built in **2006** by **Beneteau** in **France**. This model marked a new era in the history of offshore cruising boats thanks to its design,

comfort and performance. It was produced until **2014** and has been a great success, notably for its use in charter under the name of **Moorings 43.4**. The **Oceanis 43** is ideal for family or friends cruising, offering generous space and exceptional comfort.
