IDEAL FOR SOMEONE WHO WANTS TO LEAVE QUICKLY THE MINUSES OF THIS SAILBOAT - Only aesthetically - A bump in the middle starboard side at the waterline - Teak deck in average condition - Some painting to be done, as well as sanding and varnishing the companionway The boat is sold as is and without additional work from the seller's side.
