The powertrain operates flawlessly and reflects the care given to the boat over the years. The White Shark 236 presented here is far from an overlooked or worn-out unit typically found on the market: it's a clean, well-maintained, and properly cared-for model. Onboard, the layout is smooth and secure. The spacious cockpit ensures comfortable use for both fishing and cruising, while the cabin adds genuine value with storage, comfort, and versatility. The foredeck sunbathing area, aft platforms, and included equipment further enhance the boat's overall appeal. Its general condition, engine cleanliness, and overall presentation reflect the diligent upkeep it has received.
