The construction is **robust** and of high quality, ensuring good durability and increased safety at sea. All seacocks and hull penetrations were replaced in 2020. Its powerful **YANMAR 85 HP** engine provides greater safety and can withstand the varied conditions encountered at sea. Shaft-driven, with just 2000 hours, a 200-liter fuel capacity, it underwent a complete overhaul by a professional in 2020.
