## Owner's Comments

My Oceanis 55 is a complete offshore sailboat, 3 cabin version + skipper cabin, never rented, meticulously maintained with passion, extremely comfortable with numerous storage spaces and wardrobes, bright and refined, large saloon with a table that can be lowered to become a double berth. The boat is fully equipped for long-distance cruising: self-tailing genoa and solent, geneker on furler with sock, fully battened mainsail with 3 automatic reefing points. All manoeuvres are led back to the cockpit; 10 kVa generator, solar panels 3 x 200 W, 2.5 kW converter, 4 battery chargers, you will never run out of energy on board! 60l/h desalinator, diesel heating with water circulation, washing machine, 3D tender on davits with its Yamaha 4 HP engine. Mooring with 80 m of 12mm chain and Mantus 38 kg anchor. Bimini, dodger, covers for: windlass, winches, cockpit table, steering wheels... It's a seaworthy boat, very pleasant to helm (3 to 5 degrees of helm are sufficient), fast (average speeds of 8 knots under sail are common) and stable as the useful heel never exceeds 15 degrees. And it doesn't roll at anchor. The balance of the hull, the comfort of the deck plan and the high standard of fittings guarantee the owner of the Oceanis 55 beautiful sensations while sailing in the greatest safety. The positioning of the mast, the balance of the sail plan, the 45° companionway, the electric swimming platform, are major innovations that make this cruiser an easy-to-handle sailboat. A boat for great projects and intense moments, the Oceanis 55 is as convincing to the eye as it is easy to maneuver. It is equipped with the Joystick Dock&Go with which arrivals and maneuvers in ports become a breeze. A cruiser that gently takes you towards the most beautiful dreams. Combined with the cockpit loungers, the two sunbathing areas on the roof cleverly multiply the outdoor well-being spaces. At anchor, the vast aft deck extends into a terrace at water level. The Oceanis 55 opts for an uncommon level of interior comfort. Numerous windows, fully glazed shower for the owner's cabin are design choices that bring serenity. With a spacious and highly equipped kitchen, its multiple possible interior layouts and the personalization of the atmosphere through very different choices of woodwork and joinery, the atmosphere is always refined and welcoming. Taut and assertive lines and customizable hull colors at will: a cruiser that retains a unique style. Winches at the helm. The unique design that brings all the winches to the helm station allows you to perform all maneuvers alone. Highly reassuring on a 55-foot sailboat. Skipper cabin.
