## Technical Details

The Sun Liberty 34 is a 34-foot (10.36 meters) sailboat, designed to offer an excellent balance between performance, comfort, and ease of sailing. An iconic model from the Sun Freedom range in the 1980s-1990s, this versatile sailboat is sought after by sailors for its seaworthy qualities and generous interior space.

This boat is ideal for coastal or offshore cruising, whether with a small crew or solo. Its well-designed hull and efficient rigging make it a highly regarded sailboat known for its stability and maneuverability, even in rough conditions. Its sailing performance is solid, with a cruising speed of 6 to 7 knots and top speeds of 8 knots running downwind. Its bulb keel and streamlined rudder give it excellent tracking and exemplary maneuverability.

The Sun Liberty 34 offers a functional and well-thought-out interior, typically featuring a forward cabin (2 berths), a main cabin (2 to 4 berths), and a convertible saloon. Typical features include:
